DIXIE AMATEUR PROUD TO ANNOUNCE RICK WOULFE AND DIANE LANG AS HONORARY HOSTS OF RESPECTIVE EVENTS.

Coral Springs, Fl., September 12, 2008

The Dixie Amateur, one of the oldest and most prestigious amateur golf tournaments has announced Rick Woulfe as the Honorary Host of the 2008 Senior Dixie Amateur Championship to be held December 12-14 at Heron Bay Golf Club. The Dixie Amateur also announces that Diane Lang will be the Honorary Host of the Women's Dixie Amateur January 1-4.

The dates for the three divisions of the Dixie Amateur at Heron Bay Golf Club have been announced as follows:

- Senior/Super Senior Dixie Amateur: December 12, 13, 14, 2008
- Men's (Open) Dixie Amateur: December 20, 21, 22, 23, 2008
- Women's Dixie Amateur: January 1, 2, 3, 4, 2009

"To say that we are proud to have two of the world's finest amateurs as our Honorary Hosts would be an understatement," says Tournament Director Jeff Hunt. "Both of these players represent what is great about amateur golf, integrity, competitiveness and a true love of the game," adds Hunt.

Diane Lang played on the LPGA TOUR in 1984 and made the cut at the 1985 U.S. Open at Baltusrol. She quit competitive golf in 1987 to raise her family and go into real estate. In 1999 she returned to competitive golf as an amateur. She is one of only seven women to win back to back U.S. Senior Women's Amateurs (2005/2006) joining other amateur legends like Carole Semple Thompson and Alice Dye. Diane represented the United States against Europe in the Senior Women's Invitational Matches held this year.

Rick Woulfe was a College All-American at Michigan State University in 1971 and to the benefit of the game of Golf he followed that accomplishment with a trip to law school. Rick's practice has involved his life in golf almost as much as his playing accomplishments. Whether it be working with the PGA TOUR on projects or helping golf course developments he has helped better the game. His 19 USGA appearances, numerous championships, 2nd place finish in the 2006 British Senior Amateur and 6 Florida Player of the Year Awards are just a sampling of Rick's lifetime golf accomplishments.

The Dixie Amateur is one of the oldest amateur golf Championships in the United States having started at the old Miami Country Club in 1924. Rich in history and tradition the Dixie Amateur attracts the best amateurs from around the world with players invited from over 30 golf federations worldwide. Adding Rick Woulfe and Diane Lang as Honorary Hosts of the 2008 tournaments adds to the great tradition of the Dixie Amateur.
